


Get set up on iRecord

Step 1: Go to the iRecord website to set up an account: <https://irecord.org.uk/>

Step 2: Click on 'Create a new account'



Step 5: Edit your account settings

- Click on 'Edit' to update your iRecord preferences.
- DO NOT select 'Training mode' – this will treat all of your records as not real and they will not be added to the database.
- We recommend a CC BY or CC0 licence for photos or other media unless you plan to sell your photos (in which case you may prefer to set the licence to ARR).
- Updating the 'What you record' and 'where you record' sections will tailor the iRecord home page to your preferences.
